## Visitor Arrivals for April 2009 down by 11.9 Percent

There were 221,364 visitors to the Territory in April 2009, down 29,882 or 11.9 percent from April 2008. There were 155,626 cruise ship passenger arrivals this month compared to 184,125 last April. The number of cruise ship calls fell to 57 from 69 a year ago. Air arrivals, which totaled 65,738 this April, decreased by 2.1 percent when compared with last April.

#### Arrivals by District

The St. Thomas/St. John district received 54,747 air visitors, a 3.1 percent decline over the previous April. Conversely, St. Croix district received 10,991 air visitors, a 3.6 percent increase over 10,605 who arrived last April. The St. Thomas/St. John district received 155,626 cruise passengers a 15.5 percent decrease over April 2008. There were no cruise ship calls to St. Croix this month or last April.

#### Hotel Occupancy

The Territory's hotels reported occupancy rate averaged 59.6 percent-9 percentage points down from 68.6 percent last April. The rate for St. Croix was 35.9 percent compared to 55.0 percent reported last April. The rate for St. Thomas and St. John was 67.7 percent compared to 73.0 percent one year earlier. Territory-wide occupied room nights this April were 88,831 compared with 99,866 last April. Total hotel room revenue for April was \$1,756,799, a 40.3 percent loss from April 2008.

#### **Tourism Statistics January to April 2009**

There were 954,928 visitors to the Territory during the first four months of the year, a 14.4 percent drop from the 1,115,165 visitors who came one year earlier. There were 249,896 air visitors this period compared to 279,138 for the corresponding period in 2008, a 10.5 percent decline from last year. A total of 705,032 cruise passengers visited this period in 2009 or a 15.7 percent decline when compared to the 836,027 passengers who visited in 2008. There were a total of 310 cruise ship calls, about 13.4 percent fewer calls than a year ago.

April 2009 year-to-date air arrivals to the St. Thomas/St. John district were down 9.8 percent to 209,917 versus the 232,731 who came one year ago. The district of St. Croix had 39,979 air visitors or a 13.8 percent decrease. Cruise passenger arrivals fell by 16.1 percent to 700,209 from in the St. Thomas/St. John district. St. Croix received 18,040 cruise passengers for the four-month period compared to the 1,876 in 2008.

The Territory's hotel occupancy rate from January to April averaged 62.3 percent. The year-to-date hotel guest registrations were 321,445 this period. Guest Registrations were up from the following regions: The U.S. (1.2 percent), Local Residents (18.7), Europe (20.2 percent), Canada and Other Areas by (44.7 percent) and (39.4 percent). On the other hand, hotel guest decreased from Other West Indies (18.6 percent), Central America (31.7 percent), Puerto Rico (5.9 percent), and South America (9.5 percent).






