Total visitors arrivals fell by 14.8 percent in August 2009

Visitors this August reached 129,999, down 14.8 percent from last Augusts' 152,548 visitors. The number of air visitors decreased by 5.9 percent to 50,834 from 54,045 in August 2008. Cruise passenger arrivals fell 19.6 percent to 79,165 from 98,503 a year earlier.

Arrivals by District

Air arrivals for the St. Thomas and St. John district totaled 39,932 compared to 44,085 in August 2008. St. Croix air visitors, on the other hand, climbed by 9.5 percent to 10,902 this August compared to 9,960 last August.

There were 24 cruise ship calls this month compared to 30 last August. Cruise ship visitor arrivals in the St. Thomas and St. John district were 72,166, or 26.7 percent less than the 98,503 cruise arrivals last year. The island of St. Croix welcomed 6,999 cruise passengers. There were no cruise ship calls to St. Croix during the same period last year.

Hotel Occupancy

The Territory's reported hotel occupancy rate for August 2009 averaged 48.4 percent compared to 54.3 percent for the corresponding month in 2008. The rate for St. Croix was 32.2 percent compared to 39.4 percent for August 2008. The rate for St. Thomas and St. John was 54.3 percent compared to 59.9 percent a year ago. Territory-wide occupied room nights were 68,139 compared with 77,132 the previous year. A total of \$942,193 was collected in hotel room revenues this August compared to \$1,258,406 in August 2008, a revenue loss of 25.1 percent.

Tourism Statistics January to August 2009

A total of 1,532,304 visitors arrived in the Territory during the past eight months of 2009, a 12.7 percent loss, or 222,506 less visitors than the corresponding period in 2008. August 2009 year-to-date cruise passengers arrivals were 1,053,387 from 1,237,534 one year earlier. There were 478,917 air visitors or 7.4 percent fewer than the 517,276 air visitors for the same eight-month period in 2008. There were 417 cruise ship calls during this period, 13.5 percent fewer calls than last year.

The hotel occupancy rate averaged 58.7 percent for this period. There were 623,362 registered hotel guests. Guests from the United States were 6.5 percent higher than in 2008. Local resident guests increased by 7.5 percent, while guests from Puerto Rico increased 15.3 percent. Guests from Other Areas and Other West Indies grew by 7.5 percent and 30.1 percent, respectively. Guests from Central and South America declined by 18.3 percent and 23.3 percent, respectively. Conversely, the number of guests from Europe climbed by 4.4 percent, while Canadian guest increased by 22.3 percent.
